

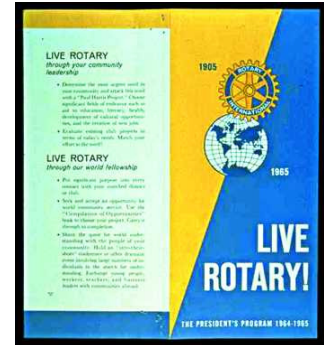


ROTARY YEAR 1964-65 President George Brown
