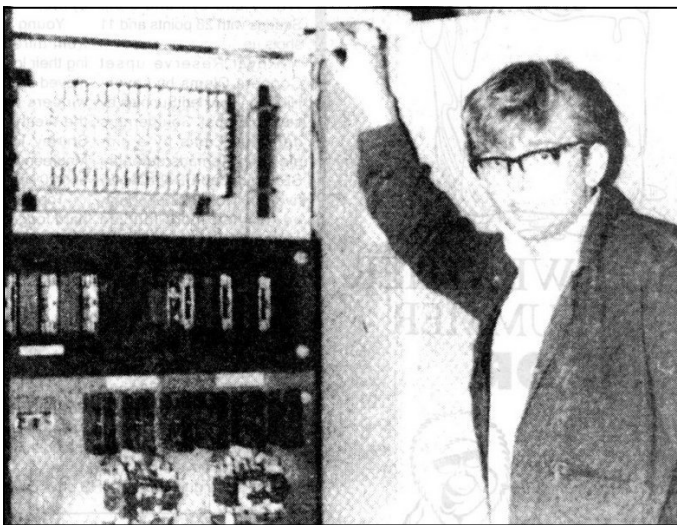




**'Stump Picking'**
