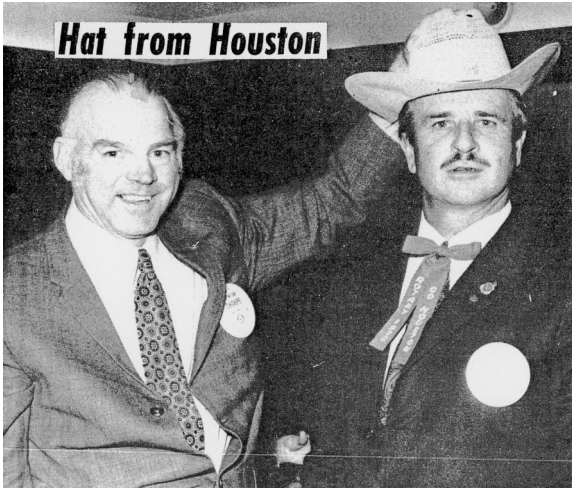


Rotary Year 1972-73 President Des Lubcke
