

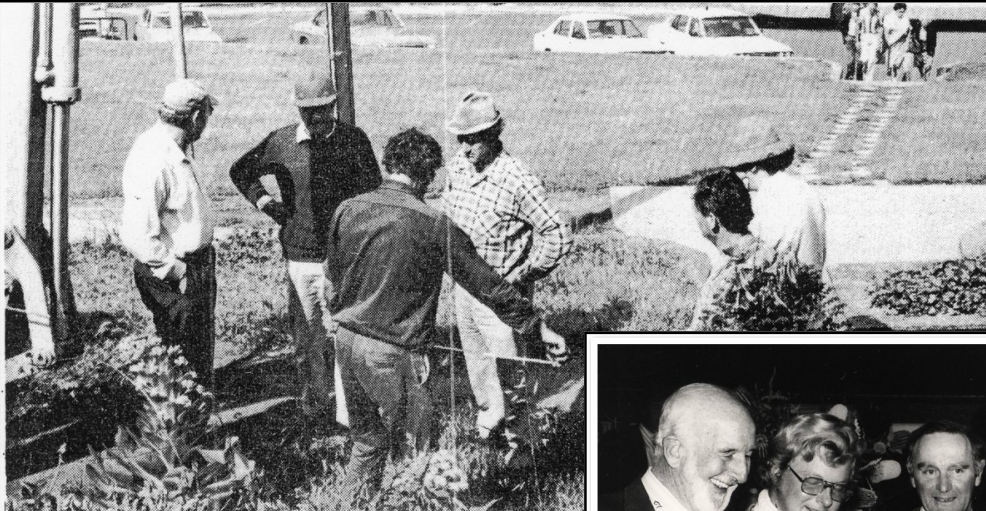


ROTARY YEAR 1979-80 President John Stuckey
