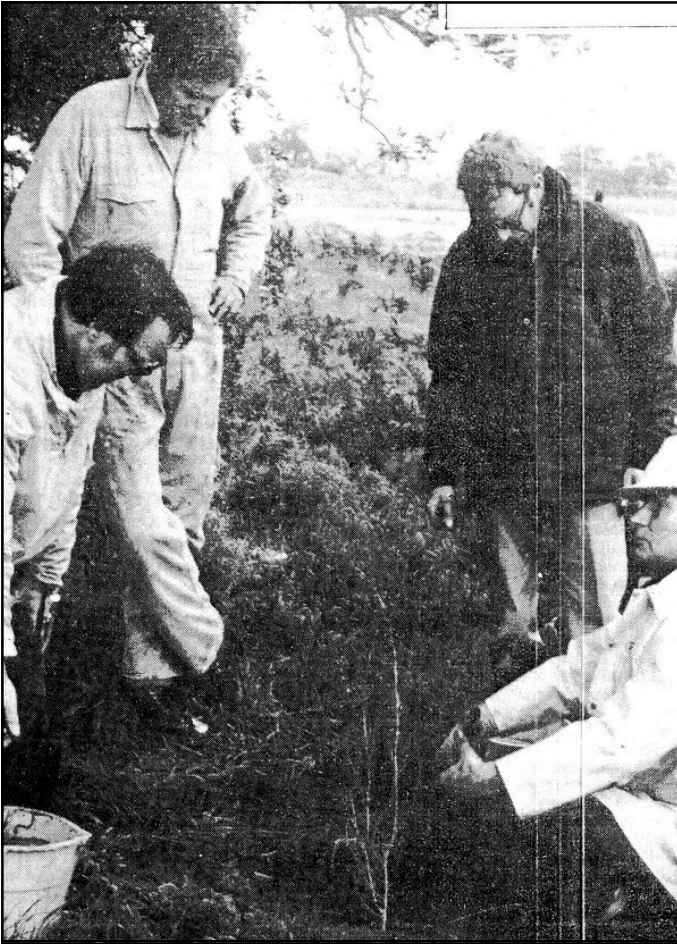

(Lake McIntyre)

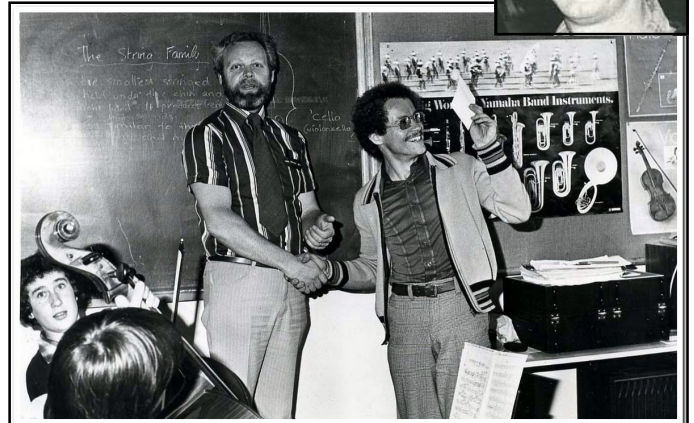
