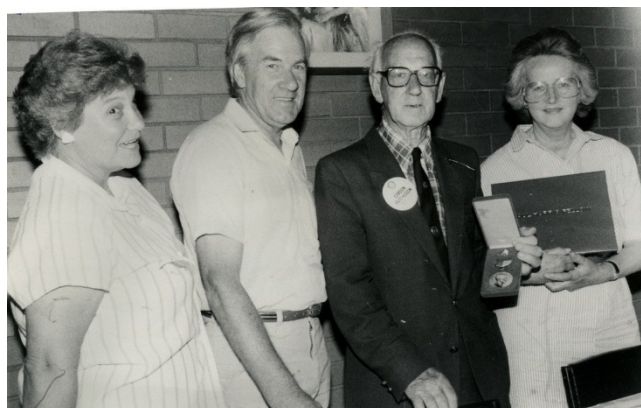
Community Health Project
