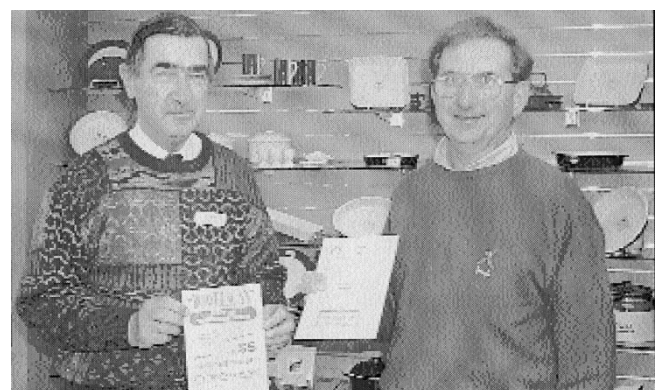
Paul Harris Sapphire
