- Saturday morning there will be a Youth Forum involving Rotaractors and University students. DG Ray is seeking home hosting for Rotaractors attending the Conference
- Saturday night's dinner will be at the Barn and is also open to members of the public at a cost of \$110.00. The main attraction will be music by James Morrison and Friends, supported by a vocalist.
- Buses will be available for attendees to travel to and from the Barn
- One Keynote Speaker will be Jill Hicks who experienced the London bombing 2 years ago and she will speak about "Making A Difference".

On the Sunday there will be a community event involving those attending the Conference. This concept proved extremely successful at last year's Conference in Geelong.

"During his official visits to District clubs DG Ray has been impressed with the financial support received for his wife's project to assist in ridding Australia of <u>Trachoma</u> by 2020, noting the effort we were making to collect used postage stamps. Australia is the only country in the developed world where Trachoma is still a problem. This project was initiated by the Rotary Club of Melbourne which was chartered in 1920 and celebrates 100 years of Rotary Service in 2020. **DG Ray reminded us that applications should be made for District Grants** (local or overseas plans) and nominations should be canvassed for Youth Exchange, RYPEN and RYLA. Rotaract is operating very successfully in some areas of the district and a former Rotary Exchange Student Anne Duddy (whom we sponsored) is keen to reform Rotaract here in Mount Gambier."






